arts & crafts

Beginning Sewing for Adults

Learn basic sewing skills and how to use a sewing machine to sew items for home or personal use. Projects include: double drawstring bag, handkerchief, pillow with zipper and craft apron. Patterns are provided.

Ceramics

In this introductory course, students will learn pinch-pot, slab-building, and coil-building techniques to create their choice of mugs, vases, tiles, and more. Artists will also learn the glaze process to finish their projects. Each piece will be fired twice; bisque and glaze fired. Students will receive a 12.5 lb bag of clay at the first session. The use of tools and glazes is included.

Jewelry and Metalcraft

Learn beginning to fine-jewelry techniques and construct custom jewelry from copper, bronze, sterling silver or gold. Students learn and practice skills in fabrication, wax carving, casting, stone setting and more in this ongoing class. Beginning levels are project-oriented with various jewelry items.

Dichroic Glass Fusing

Create your very own handcrafted art glass jewelry pieces. Design, cut, tack and stack various layers of Dichroic Art glass and small frit pieces onto a solid glass base for a threedimensional sculptural effect. The term dichroic is used because dichroic glass appears to be one color at one angle and another color at a different angle. All levels welcome. Project: earrings and pendant.

Professional Pearl and Bead Stringing

Learn how to hand-tie and knot quality jewelry, and where to purchase pearls and precious beads. Create custom jewelry for your own collection or for personal gifts. Many of our students turn what they learn into a profitable small business or a fun hobby.

Authentic Stained Glass for Beginners

This class is for first-time students. Learn the same process Louis Comfort Tiffany developed for his spectacular Tiffany lamps. No experience necessary. Your first project will be to learn to cut and grind 40 pieces of glass to fit into a beautiful hummingbird oval panel.

Authentic Stained Glass Workshop

This class is for those who have taken the beginning class and want to continue learning and making beautiful stained glass projects of their choice. Students select their own projects and work at their own pace with assistance from the instructor.

Basic Bookbinding

Learn basic binding and construction to create a beautiful hardbound book. This technique is suitable for recipe books, journals, photo albums, treasures, art journaling or printed matter. The uses are limited only by your imagination!

Basic Bookbinding Workshop

In this workshop, students who have previously completed the Basic Bookbinding class (previously The Art of Bookmaking) will have the opportunity to work on personal projects utilizing the classroom workspace, tools, and class instructor for guidance as needed.

Cook it once, but make many different dishes with it. This class features vegetarian dishes filled with vegetables, flavors, spices and herbs, yet not forgetting your protein ingredients. Dishes include Moroccan spiced vegetable couscous, warm quinoa vegetable casserole, and a Mediterranean/Tabouleh quinoa salad. Different dessert ideas will also be taught and included! Most of these dishes can be modified to add meat for the meat lovers. Hands-on participation is encouraged for this class but not required.

Annie will serve hot toasted rice green tea with the Bao for your enjoyment. Bring an apron.

French Apple Tarte Tatin and Cherry Clafoutis

These are the two most famous French pies, served all over France at restaurants and homemade by French mothers. The Tarte Tatin was named after the Tatin sisters who turned their mistake into the best apple pie when they forgot the apples burning and caramelizing in the pan. To rescue the tarte, they put a pastry dough over the apples, baked the tarte and it is now the famous upside-down Tarte Tatin. In France, during cherry season, every grandmother and mother is busy baking the Clafoutis to the delight of their family and friends. Bring an apron.
