Modesto Junior College Community Lifelong Learning is pleased to announce the educational partnership with American Academy of Professional Coders (AAPC), the world's largest training and credentialing organization. Beginning in April 2021 Community Lifelong Learning will be offering a Certified Medical Coding: CPC and Certified Medical Billing: CPB course. Each course is a sixteen-week course which includes fifty-six hours of classroom instruction.

Curriculum in both courses is aligned to prepare students for academic and professional success, as well as the technical skills to thrive on the job. The instructional methods used include reading assignments, practice exercises, practical applications, interactive video/audio lectures, chapter review tests, and final course exam. Both courses will be taught by AAPC Certified Instructor, Revina Williams.



In the medical coding course, the student will learn principles of medical coding related to the three main code books: CPT®, ICD-10-CM Code Set and HCPCS Level II. This course is recommended for anyone who is preparing for a career in medical coding for a physician's office. The medical billing course will introduce the student to health insurance and reimbursement. The student will become familiar with the health insurance industry, legal and regulatory issues, and differences in reimbursement methodologies. The student will learn principles of medical billing related to proper claim form preparation, submission and payment processing, and the follow up process. Course tuition for medical billing includes: manual, pro-fee bundle textbooks, and the AAPC student access fee. Students will access the course content thru Canvas. A one-time discount will be applied to each course when paid in full at time of registration. A two-payment plan will also be available. Upon successful completion of the course the student will receive a certificate of completion. Students will have the option to take the certification exam in-person or online with AAPC for an additional fee.
