



Camper Conduct and Consent Form

In an effort to guarantee an atmosphere that is enjoyable and conducive to learning for all, each Camps for Kids participant must follow a specific code of conduct. In addition, all students must be signed in at drop off and signed out by their parent, legal guardian or person(s) listed as authorized to pick up the child. Valid identification will be required at pick up to ensure the safety of your child. The information on this form will be valid for any and all camps the child attends. Campers 14+ may sign themselves out with parental approval on our release form.

The MJC Camps for Kids staff promises to deliver the best programs we are capable of providing. In exchange, we expect that all students, regardless of age or ability, will:

- Attend classes on time (children arriving late are disruptive to the entire class).
- Young children must be toilet trained and be able to use restroom facilities.
- Obey classroom rules listed below (will be reviewed in class with students on the first day):
 - ✓ Treat fellow students with respect and understanding. Respect classmate's projects.
 - ✓ Keep hands to self - no rough play allowed.
 - ✓ Show respect to teachers and counselors. Respect facilities.
 - ✓ No running in building.
 - ✓ No disruptive noises such as loud talking, screaming, or banging on desks.
 - ✓ If a child brings a cell phone, it must be turned off during class. No audible devices. NOTE: Community Education is not responsible for items your child may bring to camp, including cell phones.
 - ✓ No skate-shoes allowed.
 - ✓ Inappropriate language will not be tolerated.
 - ✓ Due to severe allergies in children, Camps for Kids is a peanut free zone. Please do not include nuts in your child's lunches.

In the event that there is a behavior/discipline problem, the following process will be followed:

- ✓ Major infraction: Child will be dismissed from current camp or suspended for the summer.
- ✓ Minor infraction: The instructor will issue a verbal warning and a phone call will be made informing the parent/guardian of the problem. A behavior form will be sent home with the child. The parent will need to sign and discuss the incident with their child and return the form the next day at check-in.
- ✓ If the problem occurs again, the student will be dismissed from the program.
- ✓ No refund will be granted in the event of dismissals.

I grant approval for _____ to participate in the MJC Community Education Camps for Kids and release Yosemite Community College District, Modesto Junior College Community Education, and any instructors, staff and assistants from any liability arising from his/her participation in said classes. In the event of any medical emergency while involved in program activities with Community Education, Modesto Junior College, or any of its representatives, is given the full authority to take action to protect the health and safety of the MJC Community Education student named above. Such treatment may include, but not be limited to, placing the student under the care of a doctor or in a hospital for medical examination and/or treatment, or in returning the student to their home (if such a return is deemed necessary after consultation with medical authorities). Any expenses incurred for the student's health and safety are to be paid by the student's parent/legal guardian.

As provided for in California Education Code Section 35330, I agree to waive all claims against the Yosemite Community College District and hold the District, its officers, agents and employees, harmless from any and all liability or claims, which may arise out of or in connection with my child's participation in this activity. This waiver shall not apply to any occurrences that may arise solely out of the negligence of the District, its employees or agents.
